RECOMMENDED FOR BOATS EQUIPPED WITH SMALLER HEADSAILS (SELF-TACKING SOLENT)

A genuine lightweight genoa designed to sail close-hauled in up to 8/10 knots true. It can still be used up to 110° off the apparent wind, in stronger winds (20 knots). Compared to other more specific downwind sails, it is smaller and flatter, therefore less powerful. It is hoisted on an anti-torsion luff rope.

Made of **primed Polyester** or **Mylar®** cruising composite, in triradial cut.

STANDARD FINISHES

- Luff: Kevlar® anti-torsion luff tape
- Leechline: secured to a cleat
- Telltales
- Tack: eyelet with lashing adjustments
- Clew: rings with webbing
- Head: sail webbing goes into the cable fitting
- Used on a furler
- Carrying bag

OPTIONAL

- SAKA CODE®, the storage bag invented by DELTA Voiles to safely stow downwind sails on deck
- Telltale windows
